FAMILY-FRIENDLY COMEDIAN

OWDHRY

Ahead of his show at the Grand on Saturday 16 April, recordbreaking stand-up comic **Paul Chowdhry** talks to Claire Lishman about cancel culture, diversity and making the break into acting.

iven what's happened over the past couple of years, we're all in dire need of a good laugh. Paul Chowdhry is the man to deliver just that. You might recognise him from comedy shows such as 8 Out of 10 Cats and Live at The Apollo, but his success is not limited to television; he was the first British-Asian comedian to sell out Wembley Arena and has won multiple awards for his Amazon Prime special stand up show, Live, Innit. Following on from these triumphs, Paul is touring the UK this Spring.

Coming to Wolverhampton Grand in April is a bit of a bonus for Paul, who should have really finished his **FAMILY-FRIENDLY COMEDIAN** tour last November.

"These dates coming up in March and April are additional dates due to demand. The tour was really only scheduled from September to the end of November. When this tour went on sale, the restrictions involving theatres and live entertainment were already lifted. We put the tour on with literally a month's notice, and many of the venues sold out in that short amount of time. I've been quite blown away by the response."

The Wolverhampton audience will see some material that the Autumn part of tour didn't include, as Paul has been updating his show over the last few months. "I wrote a lot of it during lockdowns, but not all of it. Some of it was written before the pandemic and some of it is really recent; since the initial part of the tour ended in November, I've added some more bits to it."

Paul has got more strings to his bow than his hugely successful stand-up career. He also boasts an impressive acting CV, having worked with several Oscar and BAFTA winners. "I just did Cruella with Emma Stone, which was in cinemas last year. And season two of Devils is coming out this Easter on Sky Atlantic. It's a fantastic drama with Patrick Dempsey. I was in all ten episodes in season one, and I'm back for season two. I also loved making The Cleaner with Greg Davies and Helena Bonham Carter, which was on BBC One last Autumn. I really enjoy the acting jobs, and it gives me a bit of variety to go along with the stand up, which will always be my bread and butter."

Stand-up has been Paul's bread and butter for nearly a quarter of a century now. He took to the stage for the first time in 1998, just after finishing his Media Studies degree. "I started a degree in Computer Science and dropped out of that." And he says that live comedy has changed in that time. "The culture has changed. The world has changed. The country has changed. And what's acceptable within the realms of entertainment has changed quite considerably, especially in comedy. You could say cancel culture is the new thing, but it's probably been around for a while. 'Lad culture' was quite big in the 1990s and early 2000s when I was starting out, which was a bit annoying as I wasn't really into it. But there's so much more diversity and different types of people doing entertainment now. Back in the late '90s when I started, there weren't many options for someone like me who is British Asian."

So why call his new show 'Family-Friendly Comedian?' "It's all down to what you can and can't say these days. If someone's considered a controversial comedian, the best thing to do is become family friendly. The audience can then decide whether I'm family-friendly or not. I leave it up to their own thoughts. After all, one man's political correctness is another man's offence."

avid Walliams is on a roll.
The celebrated comedian, talent show judge and writer remains the country's biggest-selling children's author, which is not surprising given global sales of his books have reached 45 million copies. His story BILLIONAIRE BOY visits the Grand Theatre in a hit adaptation from acclaimed producers Birmingham Stage Company.

What does David think about seeing his story take the leap from the page to performance?

"It's the most brilliant thing, seeing a book that you've written come to life on stage", he explains. "You feel like a magician because what was in your head is somehow now all real, right in front of you, so it is a very exciting thing."

Billionaire Boy tells the story of Joe Spud, a boy who is wealthy beyond anyone's wildest dreams. But it's not a typical rags to riches story. "The reason Joe is a billionaire is because his father, Len Spud, who was just a humble man who worked in a factory, came up with this brilliant idea of a creating a special toilet roll which is moist on one side and dry on

the other."

It sounds lovely! So, what would David buy today if he was given a billion pounds? "There's one thing that Joe Spud has in the book which is a water slide going down from his bedroom to a swimming pool. That is something I don't have and it really pains me!"

Many of David's stories have an epic quality, which hasn't made it easy for the experienced theatre producers, particularly when it comes to landing a helicopter on stage. "The thing is that when I write the books, I'm not thinking much beyond them being books. And, of course, in children's books you want to have lots of really exciting things happening like helicopters and fast cars and I know that does create problems for people staging it. But the brilliant thing about theatre is that with imagination, anything can be done."

The billionaire boy Joe encounters some fantastic characters on his journey and David can't resist talking about one in particular. "My favourite character in the story of Billionaire Boy is Mrs Trafe. In the story she asks Joe for money which she says she needs for a hip operation but instead

she spends it on plastic surgery. It was a lot of fun creating her horrible school dinners, giving her the surgery in the book and seeing what she does with the money."

Yet as so often in his stories, there's a more to Mrs Trafe's character than simply providing laughs. "It highlights the fact that Joe's in a pretty difficult predicament because everyone is asking him for money and they all have good reasons why they need it. But at the same time money is quite a corrupting thing and it makes people do bad things and lie to him. Mrs Trafe is really a side character but she does something pretty important in the storu."

This is David's third partnership with the Birmingham Stage Company, following their stage adaptations of *Gangsta Granny* and *Awful Auntie*, and he has hugely enjoyed seeing this production. "It's a really fun show because in a way this is the most comic book. It's a story with an emphasis on jokes and silly situations and obviously the whole thing is quite surreal with someone having so much money. So it's turned into a really fun theatre show and I loved seeing it on stage in the West End."

"A THEATRE WITH ITS COMMUNITY AT HEART"

ithout the community what would Wolverhampton Grand Theatre be? Probably an empty building without life and soul.

The Grand has always stood to serve the community, providing the widest range of art forms to suit all tastes. Since re-opening in 2021, the Audience Development Team have made it a priority to expand the programme even further with the help of our dedicated ambassadors.

This started with a celebration of Indian dance and film in October with a curation from award-winning South Asian Arts organisation Jaivant Patel Dance followed by a screening of the Bollywood classic Devdas.

Audience Development Consultant Hardish Virk commented,

"Devdas is an epic Bollywood love story with incredible dance and music set pieces. We wanted to make this more than a cinema screening - we wanted this to be an event. The live elements curated by Jaivant Patel Dance added magic through the dance performances. South Asian foods and drinks added to the atmosphere as majority South Asian audiences visited the Grand, many for the first time. Grand staff support was pivotal in the success of the event, from the marketing through to looking after the new audiences.

In November The Grand welcomed Rush Theatre Company with their

production of RUSH — A Joyous Jamaican Journey, documenting the Windrush generations journey from Jamaica to the UK, Audience Development Consultant Tonia Daley-Campbell reflects,

"One of the most talked about things before the show arrived was the marketing, mainly the fabulous large window vinyl right at the front of the Grand Theatre. This was so visible it allowed other black led production companies to see that at the Grand Theatre Wolverhampton they could be front and centre when it comes to marketing their shows.

This all resulted in a sell-out show with a waiting list of people wanting a ticket! On the night it was as bright, and full of energy off stage in the auditorium with our rich and colourful audience as it was on stage with the fabulous show. And the Jamaican feel extended to the bar areas where Jamaica's famous Wray and Nephew rum punch was on sale alongside Dragon Stout. We also partnered with local company, The Original Patty company, who sold traditional Jamaican curry patties to our audience.

Also, we had a very special gift for a member of Wolverhampton's Windrush community, our very own Mr Campbell, whose personal story features in a special 'in conversation' film the Grand are producing called A JOYOUS JAMAICAN CONVERSATION, which will show at the Lighthouse Cinema on Windrush Day

2022 (22 June). He was presented with a seat plaque with his name on and he was over the moon. All the years he had lived in Wolverhampton he had never been to the Grand Theatre and this is why we do what we do."



"After nearly four years of working with the Wolverhampton Grand Theatre, I am confident to say that the Grand has demonstrated its' commitment to becoming a theatre for all citizens of the city. Change will not happen overnight, but the groundwork is strong, and the audience development ambitions at the theatre are real."





The Work Continues In The Community...

Each year the Outreach Team coordinate a schools project themed around the pantomime. In 2021, International Storyteller Peter Chand, led workshops in schools encouraging primary school children to develop their creative writing and storytelling. The winning stories were displayed throughout the run of Cinderella in The Grand's foyer.

This year we've introduced new dates to our programme of Memory Cafés, with entertainment tailored for the Black, African and Caribbean community. Music has been proven to help those living with dementia and these additional cafés featuring gospel, soul, motown and reggae will allow more people to enjoy the benefits of attending a Memory Café.

We've also opened up our stage to local filmmakers and performers. Grand Theatre Ambassador Simone Stewart filmed her new online series 'Getting2Know' from the Grand Theatre stage, interviewing a host of prominent local figures against the backdrop of our beautiful auditorium, while performers from Gazebo Theatre took to our stage for the very first time to film their own creative pieces.

What's Next?

So what does 2022 have in store? Tonia said, "I'm really blown away with the Grand Theatre's commitment to future programming. I was very keen that we didn't sit still after the success of Rush. I didn't want this to be a one night only effect, but to continue to build a more diverse programme of shows appealing to all different types of Black audiences. It was important that we kept the momentum going so our new audiences could clearly see it's not just a one off type of thing. Booking Rush Theatre Company's new show The King of Reggae (formerly known as Bob Marley-The Man- The Music) was so important in making sure we develop and nurture that relationship.

Both myself and Tim Hession, the Grand Theatre's Head of Programming and Production Co-ordinator, decided we would go looking for shows to program and we came across Black Is The Colour Of My Voice which we feel is a brilliant opportunity to see how drama and one women shows can do well with the right subject matter.

The Soweto Gospel Choir will visit for one night only in October. Even though the show is a while away we have made a plan to really push this show throughout our networks and to try and really target our African Diaspora within the local community.

And local company Blackstory
Partnership visit with a brand new
production called She's Royal, which
unveils the hidden relationship between
Queen Victoria and two extraordinary

and Sophia Duleep Singh"

Hardish commented: "2022 features a diverse range of local and national South Asian talent from high profile comedians, Paul Chowdhry to local dance competition, Just Naach Wolverhampton, the film screening of the Indian comedy drama, English Vinglish alongside the recent performance of international singer, Satinder Sartaaj. The Grand recognises the role of programming when developing new audiences and it will continue to diversify the stories and entertainment presented on its stage to reflect this.

AJOYOUS JAMAICAN CONVERSATION

AN 'IN CONVERSATION' CELEBRATION OF JAMAICA'S WINDRUSH GENERATION

olverhampton Grand
Theatre is known for the
stories it tells on stage
but this summer it will present
its first ever self-produced film
screening, A JOYOUS JAMAICAN
CONVERSATION, an 'in conversation'
celebration of Jamaica's Windrush
Generation.

Hosted by Grand Theatre Audience Development Consultant Tonia Daley-Campbell and featuring contributions from respected local resident Mr Reuben Campbell and Rush Theatre Company Members Owen Miller, Ken 'Dread' McLean and Orvil Pinnock, the film grew from a smaller idea, as Tonia explains.

'In the run up to Rush Theatre
Company's visit to the Grand last
year with their sell out production of
RUSH A Joyous Jamaican Journey,
which tells the history of Jamaica and
the Windrush Generation, the team
at the Grand wanted to highlight the
Jamaican contribution to local life by
filming some short pieces of film to
share on social media.

We invited **Mr Campbell**, who arrived in Wolverhampton in 1962, to share his personal experiences of moving from Jamaica to the city and forging a new life here, which included running the Rising Star Club, and asked the guys from Rush to share

their parents' stories, alongside their memories of growing up within the Jamaican community in the Midlands.

When the footage came back we realised we had something much greater than the original idea, we saw a beautiful free flowing conversation with so much potential that justified a bigger stage'

They were invited over by the British Government to help rebuild the country and arrived not knowing what to expect, they faced struggles but they worked hard, raised families and succeeded'.

Orvil Pinnock, Rush Theatre
Company's Musical Director, highlights
the importance of preserving the
Windrush generations story on film:
'Very sadly many of that generation
have passed, and as each person
passes their contribution is lost. But
if we're talking about it, it means
people have the opportunity to learn,
the younger generation can begin to





head of hit Broadway and West End musical WAITRESS coming to Wolverhampton, singer/songwriter Sara Bareilles talks to Theo Bosanquet about writing the music and lyrics for the show and bringing it to the Grand Theatre, allowing it to be seen by audiences outside of the world's theatre capitals.

"It's my pride and joy" she begins, "I grew up in a small town and I couldn't get to Broadway, so I was reliant on the theatres close to me. 

Michelle Collins

tells us about landing the role of Miss Scarlett in the new UK tour of **CLUEDO**.

e all need a bit of glamour in our lives, don't we darling?' says Michelle Collins. The glamour in question comes in a role she brings to life on stage here in Wolverhampton, that of Miss Scarlett, the most glamorous and potentially most deadly member of the cast of CLUEDO, the new play based on the film Clue and, originally of course, the murderous board game that Michelle was obsessed with as a child.

'We all wanted to be Miss Scarlett,' says Michelle. She is one of the most iconic characters, along with Colonel Mustard and Professor Plum maybe, which makes it more difficult to play,' she goes on. 'Me and my sister would go and stay with my five cousins and we would all fight for that part but because I'm the bossy one, I would always get it.' She laughs. 'And I think because of lockdown people have gone back to board games, just to be together really.'

Then she remembers how her mum once bought her a board game that turned out — to her horror! - to be a ouija board: 'Doing séances at the age of 10! But it's funny that board games have brought us back together when you find out that Cluedo was actually invented during the Second World War, when people were stuck at home during air raids, almost out of boredom!' It adds a lovely dollop of nostalgia to the fun — and the murder! — of Cluedo.

It may sound a bit of a strange concept, a play based on a film based on a board game but to Michelle it makes perfect sense. 'It's a comedy whodunit,' she says of the story of a group of disparate people who turn up to a mansion one dark and stormy night at the behest of the one person they all have in common: their blackmailer. 'I've done a Miss Marple and everyone loves those,' she goes on.

'And it's great to dress up in period clothes, 40s clothes. So glamorous! And we are in the hands of the perfect director in Mark Bell...' he did the smash hits The Play That Goes Wrong and A Comedy about A Bank Robbery. 'It takes a very particular director to get the best out of something as fun and escapist as this.'

As for her character... 'I'll have to have my own take on her but it's really exciting to play someone who, like most women, has more going on than you see on the surface. She has a history. She's very smart, looks glam and dressed up but she's the smart cookie. The play will be very funny, very dry, a little dark at times but ultimately great entertainment, it's feel-good, and it will have something for all the family.



hen did you last play Mrs Johnstone and how is it returning to the show?

I last played her in 2012 and returning to it was scary at first. The first time I did it I'd never done a musical or been a part of the theatre world so when [producer] Bill Kenwright called me I think I turned it down four times. I was like 'No, you're OK!' but he persuaded me to audition, and my audition was terrible. But he saw something in me and within a week I was on stage in the Phoenix Theatre. It was such a whirlwind. Since then, I've done lots of other roles, mainly funny ones, so to come back to such a dramatic role is very scary but it's like a dream come true. They'd asked me to come back before but I had to be ready, and now I am.

What makes her such an iconic musical theatre role?

It's because of her strength and the emotions you have to go through when you're on stage. She starts as a young girl in her 20s, then within 20 minutes she's got seven kids and has to give one away. It's a big part and it's a big part for a woman, which is rare at my age. My window is tiny to get a part where you're on for more than ten minutes. She's a strong female lead and she's so real. Every mother in this country can relate to her on some level because of how real she is. Every mother must see something in Mrs Johnstone that they've also gone through. I know I can. I've got two sons so her Micky and Eddie are my Morgan and Jonah. My kids have had troubles, I've had troubles, and the way I look at it is: I don't have to play her, I just have to

Are you discovering new things about her and the show this time round?

[Laughs] Yes, she's not such a feisty tiger as I thought when I first did the show. They used to call me 'The Feisty Tiger Mrs Johnstone'. I come from a family of four, we grew up on a council estate, we had

no money, I used to go to school in jelly shoes even in November, and my mum was a tough cookie. You didn't mess with her and that's how I thought Mrs J. was or at least that she was how I was, like 'Don't mess with my kids or I'll come at you with a baseball bat'. But now I'm older I've mellowed. I'm 50 now and I'm not so bouncy as I was ten years ago, so my take on her is much more grounded. She's stronger without being quite so feisty.

It's such an emotional rollercoaster for the audience. Is it the same for you as a performer?

It is, yes. There are a couple of parts in the show, without giving spoilers, where it rips me to shreds. I do it as though someone is about to take one of my children and I can't hold back. I have to feel it every time I do it.

His grouchy on-stage demeanour is particularly magnetic. Audiences really relate to Jack's exasperation with the idiocies of the modern world. He explains, "that persona has always chimed with audiences. People enjoy hearing me articulate things they'd been half-thinking themselves. That's where the identification comes in

"My job as a comedian is to locate those things, put them into words and make them funny for people who lead much more productive lives and don't want to spend time doing that. That's my silly job!"

So, what will Jack talk about in his new show? "At first I thought everything would need to be seen through the lens of Covid. I was saying to myself, 'how long is this going to go on for? At this rate, Covid is going to go on longer than one of Robert Preston's questions!"

However, Jack carries on, "I was overthinking things. People are actually more concerned with going out and having a good time. So in the show I make references to Covid – it would be odd not to – but I move on relatively quickly. I am aware that every comedian will have material on Covid and I don't want to be the guy who overdoes that. At some point, people will think, 'let's move on'.

Whether something is funny or not takes precedence over all else in Jack's show. "The audience never misunderstand me. They either find it funny or they don't. I've tried every other way, but I know that if it's not funny, it's my fault. It's not the audience's fault. I can't get away from that, and that's very disappointing!"

Jack, who has also enjoyed a stellar TV career on programmes such as *The* Jack Dee Show, Jack Dee's Saturday Night, Jack Dee's Happy Hour and Jack Dee Live at the Apollo ("in fact, I've probably appeared in every TV show with my name in the title"), reveals why he has called the show OFF **THE TELLY**. "The title comes from my disenchantment with the kind of telly I get offered now. I really won't do anything with 'Celebrity' in the title anymore.

"Artists are known for doing things they're really good at, whereas celebrities are known for doing things they're really terrible at. They go on Bake Off and make an absolute tit of themselves, and that's how they make a living."


Will Jack be appearing in the next run of Celebrity Love Island, then? "Not this season. I'll let everyone else get buffed up first. I don't want it to be unfair. Other people have to have time to get fit so they can catch up with me. Otherwise I'd win too easily."





he hoped she'd get an opening night audience of 50, within two weeks, audiences four times that were flocking to see Apphia Campbell's intimate one woman portrayal of the life of Nina Simone. From studios around the world, to the Edinburgh Fringe Festival, BLACK IS THE COLOR OF MY VOICE is about to take on its biggest stage ever at Wolverhampton Grand.

Sitting down with Campbell, Scott Bird discovers her journey from student to stage that started at college with the question, "who is Nina Simone?"

"I found out about Nina in senior year. Everyone had to write a one-person show. I didn't write mine about her, but it was during that process that a friend said to me "you should definitely write a show about Nina Simone" and I said, "who is Nina Simone!?"

"There and then I started listening to her music and I instantly fell in love with her voice. I've never experienced a voice with that kind of pain. Every melody and every note really combine to tell a story. I started researching her and her activism. She continued to perform these songs even though it was detrimental to her career - I absolutely admire the courage that she had."

But how do you turn an autobiography and a catalogue of songs into a show?

For Campbell there was a story arc that she couldn't ignore — Simone's relationship with her father.

"People focussed a lot on the erratic side of her behaviour, I wanted them to fall in love with who she was as a woman, as I did, and understand the woman behind the music. It was when I narrowed down the relationship between her and her father, I found key moments in her life that I felt were the turning points for her. She was in front of an audience and her parents had to stand up and move seats – those are the moments that tell the story; her first real experience of racism, the rejections, the struggles but the love... and it all aligns itself to her songs."

Similarities with Simone have had a big impact on Campbell and her outlook on life.

"Life imitating art, we had a very similar journey in the discovery of our voices, singing in bars during international travel, it's where we both found our voices.

Previously, when I was living in New York and trying to audition for Broadway, my vocal sound wasn't the sound I would hear in audition rooms. I would try and make my voice sound like the other peoples' voices. It took a long time for me to accept my voice and the uniqueness of my sound. Now, I think of a quote from her, "freedom is no fear" and if she could have lived her life with no fear, it would

have been so different. I always think about her and her strength when I look at the choices I make in life, she's been a great guide to me."

While Campbell connects with Simone's strengths, she sees her audiences connecting in a different way.

"What people really connect to is her vulnerability. In this show people get to see the person behind the icon, there's no façade and we do that by having a set that is just the bedroom, just her and keepsakes of her father. I think people really connect with her because it's an intimate experience with just them and this woman who goes through every emotion."

How does Campbell feel about taking that intimate experience to a bigger stage?

"This is going to be the biggest capacity audience and I've never performed it on a stage this big! Moving from fringe theatres and smaller capacity theatres to one as big as Wolverhampton Grand is incredibly exciting and I know that it's going to work just as well. I know what people connect to and I allow myself to be extremely vulnerable, truthful and in the moment. No matter what, this show translates to an audience of one hundred or indeed the twelve hundred that the Grand Theatre holds! I can't wait to see you there!"







or anyone who isn't familiar with the story, what is The Commitments about?

THE COMMITMENTS is about a group of young people from Dublin in the 1980s who form a soul band to try and escape the poverty trap they've been growing up in.

You are directing this time round, but you previously performed in the show. Tell us more about that.

I made my West End debut with the show when it opened in September 2013, playing Dean Fay, the sax player in the band who spirals off on his own path to a jazz career. I played that role for over two years. During that time at one point both the lead actor playing Jimmy and the two understudies were off due to illness or injury and I was given the call and asked if I'd play Jimmy that night.

Were you familiar with the story before it came to be a stage show?

I'd seen the film, I think almost every Irish person has, it's part of our national psyche. Roddy Doyle's books and influence are huge, as a Man Booker winner and such a big international success he's hugely influential, so it's hard not to be familiar with it growing up in Dublin.

And Roddy Doyle adapted The Commitments for the stage.

Yes, it's great to have had so much input from Roddy Doyle, and his adaptation works really well for stage with subtle changes to the dialogue here and there to get the most out of the theatre setting. The adaptation is a combination of the book and the film, so you get the best of both worlds; Roddy's wit and dialogue and a brilliant soul back catalogue.

What is your favourite part of the show?

Oh that's tough! I think it's probably when the band come together and play for the first time, and they become more than the sum of their parts. I think playing music together with other people for the first time is one of the most exciting things a musician gets to do, and that scene really captures it. Although Papa Was A Rolling Stone is one of my favourite songs so I'd have to say that is one of my favourite bits too.



rom songs of freedom to gospel classics like Amazing Grace and Leonard Cohen's Hallelujah; South Africa's three-time Grammy award-winning SOWETO GOSPEL CHOIR is bringing their Freedom Concert to Wolverhampton Grand Theatre.

The Soweto Gospel Choir's Freedom concert in honour of father of the nation; Nelson Mandela, promises to be an "uplifting and joyous" rendition of songs that will take you on a journey through South Africa's vibrant culture and rich history, before and after apartheid.

In June 1976, the Soweto uprisings brought about a shift in the consciousness of black South Africans. He recalls key moments with the choir. "Stevie Wonder once heard us singing during sound check and made an impromptu decision to add us to the line-up for his set." The choir has been blessed to meet many of the legends of our time however Shimmy's favourite moment by far was when the choir presented their first ever Grammy to the late Nelson Mandela. "He was such a force. I have no idea how he managed to handle struggle and pain with so much poise and grace," he said. Five Grammy nominations and three wins later, Shimmy can't wait to grace the stage in Wolverhampton!

What is he hoping will be the audience's take away? "I would say to anyone coming to see the show, prepare to be uplifted. You may not understand everything, but you will most definitely feel." The Soweto Gospel Choir's message is one of joy, peace, and healing. "The songs we sing are deeply profound words of faith. We minister in song. We are looking forward to taking people on a journey and showing them how our songs of struggle became songs of freedom and hope. DARA O'BRIAI

Funnyman **Dara O'Briain** speaks to James Rampton about his new live show **SO... WHERE WERE WE?** and his uncanny resemblance to Beyonce.

t is five years since Dara Ó Briain last started a nationwide tour. It would have happened sooner, he says, "but there was a small matter that intervened and caused an interregnum.... Cards on the table; I ate a bat and decided to take some time off."

This is typical of Dara, an immensely entertaining presence on and off stage. You will be delighted to hear that he is returning to the live arena in the spring with a major new national tour entitled "SO... WHERE WERE WE?", which visits the Grand Theatre for two nights on Friday 4th and Saturday 5th November 2022.

So what subjects will Dara be covering in "So... Where Were We?"? "I'm always loath to say, 'this is what's in the show'. Nobody asks Beyonce, 'what's your new album about?'"

Of course, he adds with a laugh, "I'm very much Beyonce in this analogy! The similarities are uncanny. Over the years, I've had lots of letters from her saying, 'don't tread on my IP'."

One topic Dara will definitely be mentioning on stage is the pandemic. He explains, "I keep saying, 'I'm not going to talk about it', but it's very difficult for it not to creep in and colour what you're talking about. The pandemic was weirdly specific, but also incredibly universal.

"You can't escape the fact that it's been the one thing we've all done for the past two years. It is very difficult not to allude to home-schooling or isolation. It would be bizarre not to go, 'wasn't that a bit mad?' But you want to go easy on it because people are very much looking forward to moving on from it."

The Irishman proceeds to disclose that the second half of the show will be a long, moving and yet very funny story centring on a very personal revelation. Dara says, "I've never told this story before outside of the third bottle of wine at a dinner party.

"The story is full of revelations. You'll be reeling from surprise after surprise, each

one more surprising than the last. After one show recently, someone said to me, 'that's a lot more personal than you've done in the past'. 'Of course it is,' I replied. 'I haven't got any other stories — nothing has happened in the last two years! I'd love to tell you funny stories from the road, but I've just been sitting at home for the last two years."

This section of the show emphasises that comedy can be a very good vehicle for articulating something quite profound. "The tension you create with a truelife story is both serious and funny, and that's great fun to play with," Dara says.


"You ramp up the tension and the audience are thinking, 'hang on, this could be serious', and then you drop it. The audience then really laugh as they're releasing all that tension."

The comedian closes by reflecting on what he hopes audience members will be saying to each other as they leave "So... Where Were We?" "Well, if they come out in any way intrigued or moved, that's fantastic but first and foremost I just want them to be entertained."

Above all, though,
Dara trusts that his
audiences will be filing
out of the theatre having
enjoyed a brilliantly
entertaining night out.
"I'd just be delighted if
they say, 'yeah, that was
funny' to each other as
they're getting into the car.
Ultimately, that's what
I want."



e has a pantomime career that includes some of the country's greatest theatres and has starred alongside panto royalty and Hollywood stars... following a triumphant turn in Cinderella last year, Tam Ryan sat down with Scott Bird to talk about why the Wolverhampton pantomime tops them all ahead of his return for this year's production of ALADDIN.

But where did it all start? Was Tam always destined for a career on the stage?

"My mum was a principal boy and my dad was a pantomime dame, so you can imagine the confusion for someone who is seven or eight years old, which is when I first got a grasp of what it was my parents did for a living... I grew up around pantomime with my mum dressed as a man and my dad dressed as a woman, it was great!"

Stepping back into Wolverhampton Grand, not even two months after finishing the run of *Cinderella*, Tam looks to a photograph that adorns the wall on the dress circle level.

"I love that there's a signed picture up of Keith Harris and Orville from what happened to be his final ever pantomime appearance, here in Wolverhampton. It always makes me smile because I first met Keith in the mid-eighties, when my parents appeared alongside him in pantomime, and we remained friends. It was through my parents and Keith that I was introduced to the real panto icons of the day."

"Everything I do on stage is rooted in those early days and watching the greats like the Chuckle Brothers and the Grumbleweeds gave me a great understanding of how to entertain and make an audience laugh. 'Panto' itself is evolving now but the heart of it remains the same. That conveyor belt that brought you Joe Pasquale, Brian Conley, Bradley Walsh and such acts might not be there anymore, but panto needs that type of act. Whilst some might say that 'variety is dead', pantomime is as popular as ever and it's very special, it's ours, it's British and it's a beautiful thing to be part of keeping that tradition alive and going."

Having starred in almost 20 pantomimes all around the country, including many at Manchester's acclaimed Opera House alongside the

likes of David Hasselhoff and Priscilla Presley, Tam had taken a four-year break from panto to star as Buddy The Elf in *Elf The Musical*. The 2021 tour of *Elf* finished early enough to allow Tam back into the world of pantomime and Wolverhampton was quite the appeal...

"Firstly, Wolverhampton Grand is perfect for panto, because it's a very intimate auditorium but it seats a mighty 1,200 people which is great for comedy because you still get the big audience numbers and lots of laughs but none of the comedy gets lost. I knew that because I'd played here before, but never in panto. When the job first came up, there were a few cities to pick from. Wolverhampton came last alphabetically on the list but anyone who's done or seen a lot of pantos at the Grand knows there's a rich culture of pantomime and there's been a panto here every year since it opened nearly 130 years ago."

"As a performer, you don't just get given a part in the Wolverhampton panto, you earn it because everything is right here, and the pantomime culture here is so precious that you have to treat the Grand panto with the utmost respect it deserves. Cinderella was perfect, I don't mind going on record saying that it was the best pantomime I've been involved in for the experience, the enjoyment and the quality of show... even with the backdrop of covid and the many challenges that brought in terms of keeping the show going, it was a dream of a panto season."

"From day one of rehearsals right through to the end of the run everything felt so right with the cast and the audiences - it's like the early stages of dating... you know if you're going to like them and if they're going to like you and I can honestly say there wasn't one single show of the run where I thought "this isn't going to work..." – the Wolverhampton panto is a very good fit for me and I can't wait to come back for *Aladdin!*"

A firm audience favourite, Tam will return with his signature charm and bucketloads of comedy this year alongside a star cast to be announced soon! Tickets for **ALADDIN** are now on sale and are flying out of the Box Office – you don't need a three wishes to make your Christmas one to remember, it's all here at the Grand Theatre in one magical family adventure!

ere at Wolverhampton Grand, we realise the importance of live theatre on everyone in the community, especially our younger generation. Often, pantomime is a child's first experience of theatre and watching live performance helps them to develop in so many ways. Key skills in language, communication and confidence are all aided by drama and theatre and we want to make sure as many children have access to that and the many educational and behavioural benefits it inspires.

We realise that circumstances may prevent families from accessing theatre and so we do everything we can to make sure we can still reach everyone. How do we do that? We head out onto the road and visit schools with an interactive touring pantomime!

Imagine the fun of the Grand Theatre live in your school hall as your children experience live theatre for the first time!

As part of our **INTRO TO PANTO** school's tour, they'll see:

- A much-loved fairytale come to life
- Colourful costumes and make up
- Professional sets and props
- Singing, dancing, and acting by professional actors who have performed on the Grand's stage.

All while learning about the wonderful British tradition of pantomime!

Every autumn a small troop of actors visit local primary schools to perform the **INTRO TO PANTO** workshop and a mini version of the pantomime.

The project has brought joy to 35,000 children over the last 5 years.

Fun from start to finish

James Collins, Outreach Manager for Creative Learning explains more:

"The 30-minute workshop is aimed at Years 4, 5 and 6 and explains panto history: from its roots in Italy and commedia dell'arte and adoption by the Victorians to the Christmas tradition we love today.

Children also learn the "rules" of panto and typical routines. We kick off with a song. They learn to cheer the good characters and boo the baddies.

Of course, there's the infamous ghost

and "he's behind you" gag. Everyone really gets into it — it can get pretty noisy!

The workshop is followed by a 40-minute "highlights" version of the panto – this year **ALADDIN**.

It's minimal disruption for the school. We only need 40 minutes to set up and some power sockets."

The show must go on!

Last year more than 7,000 children (and their teachers) experienced the magical world of *Cinderella!*

James continues: "It's always

great to see the children's reactions, especially last year, going back into school's after many months of lockdowns. It was an absolute joy to see children experiencing the much-missed magic of live theatre again!"

Associate Director of Audiences & Communication, Vicky Price and Outreach Manager - Access & Inclusion Remy Lloyd reflect on the last 10 years.

When I joined The Grand Theatre back in 2009 discussions were being held about producing a Relaxed Performance of the pantomime, a new concept of theatre that was very much in its infancy.

Soaking in the conversations around me I gleaned that a Relaxed Performance provided a vital way to access the theatre for people on the Autism Spectrum, those with a sensory processing disorder and/or additional access needs.

In order to make a performance "relaxed" the pantomime is carefully adapted by reducing the volume and removing flashing lights, loud bangs and any other elements of the show that may be stress-inducing.

At the time there were only a handful of theatres trialling these performances and mostly based in London. So, when we launched a Relaxed Performance of *Snow White* in 2012 we were the first theatre in the Midlands to do so. Within a couple of months of being on sale it had sold out and it has continued to do so ever since.

I have been involved with Relaxed Performances since 2015 while working as a Front of House Manager and have loved every minute of it since. It's not just the auditorium that transforms for the event, all our front of house area is rearranged and adapted to create a more comfortable environment and to include a Sensory Room, a Quiet Room and various places to relax away from the auditorium.

After listening to feedback from our customers and to celebrate our tenth anniversary, we will be holding two relaxed performances for our 2022/23 pantomime, **ALADDIN!** A Saturday morning show tailored to families, in addition to our usual Thursday morning showing which has been popular with school groups since they began back in 2012! This is an opportunity for families to experience the magical world of pantomime together!

Relaxed performances are also a great chance to bring young children (under 5's) to the theatre for the first time as the usual auditorium rules are relaxed, more movement and noise is expected, and an open-door policy applies throughout the performance.

The family relaxed performance will take place on Saturday 10 December at 11am and the School's performance will be on Thursday 5 January 2023 at 11am

Dan and Lois Raven met whilst working at the Grand in 2005 and they have two children Elliot and Anya. Dan is a General Technician in the technical department and has worked on Relaxed Performances since the beginning.

When their son Elliot was diagnosed with Autism, Lois became a founding member of **EMBRACE AUTISM WV** a support group for parents with children on the autism spectrum in Wolverhampton.

Here she explains about her lived experience,

"Relaxed Performances provide the opportunity for families like mine to experience the magic of theatre with no judgement. I came to see the panto twice last year, once with Anya and once with Elliot. We are so excited that this Christmas we will be able to come as a family group.

It's hard for Elliot to access the community. As a theatre family we attend as many events as possible but if Elliot becomes overwhelmed and starts to distract others we would leave, even if he was enjoying it. Which is really sad.


As parents we feel less stressed at Relaxed Performances. There's lots of shouting and flapping from the audience around us, but it's an environment that is made to feel comfortable for us."

Dan added: "The key is the kids being able to do their own thing without the fear of others shushing them and we don't have to worry about him leaving if he gets overwhelmed. The quiet rooms and sensory rooms are brilliant because we don't need to physically leave the building, then we have the opportunity to go back into the auditorium if we can.

More of these events would benefit us greatly." **EMBRACE AUTISM WV** will be holding a coffee morning in The Grand Theatre's Encore Lounge on Thursday 12 May from 10am – 12noon.
